Obstetrics/Gynecology	<p>To be eligible for renewal of ABOG certification in Hospice and Palliative Medicine, Diplomates must hold a valid underlying certificate in obstetrics and gynecology or an ABOG subspecialty and complete the ABOG Maintenance of Certification program.</p> <p>A Diplomate who holds a non-time-limited certificate in obstetrics and gynecology or an ABOG subspecialty must enter the MOC program in the year their HPM certificate expires in order to maintain their HPM certificate.</p> <p>A Diplomate who holds a time-limited certificate in obstetrics and gynecology or an ABOG subspecialty must continue to participate in Maintenance of Certification in order to maintain their Hospice and Palliative Medicine certificate.</p>	<p>https://www.abog.org/bulletins/2018%20HPM%20Bulletin.pdf page 7</p>
