

## Browser & OS Support

We focus our support for *any* browser on *any* platform to those that have a significant market share, as determined by the number of active learners we see using them in our traffic analysis. Current support is for Chrome 86 & 87, and Firefox 83, 84 on Windows and macOS. On Microsoft Windows 10, support is for Edge 87 & Internet Explorer 11. On macOS, Safari 14 is current. Note: Reporting, Admin and Authoring are not supported on mobile platforms, Android or iPad.

**NOTE: Our support is based on standard browser packages downloaded directly from the manufacturer, with *no* enterprise or individual modifications, especially extensions.**

*Amplifire is tested and supported only on desktops, laptops and tablets, not on mobile phones, although it may function effectively on phone browsers.*

\*Microsoft is dropping support for certain apps and services that use Internet Explorer 11 later in 2021. Additionally, they will be ending support for the legacy version of the Microsoft Edge desktop app on March 9, 2021, in favor of a new version of Microsoft Edge. This means that the legacy version of the desktop app will no longer receive security updates. The recommended browser for Microsoft 365 apps and services is the new Microsoft Edge, which follows their Modern Policy.
