Several unusual usage configurations that presented an Application Error to users have been resolved to prevent the error.

## Browser & OS Support

We focus our support for *any* browser on *any* platform to those that have a significant market share, as determined by the number of active learners we see using them in our daily traffic analysis.

Current support is for Firefox 56 & 57. Newly tested versions of Chrome are 62 and 63. On Windows 10, support is for Edge 14 & 15, plus Internet Explorer 11, which is the only remaining Microsoft legacy browser in significant use. On the Mac platform for OSX, Safari 10.1 and 11 are tested. On Mobile Safari, iOS 9, 10, 11.

**NOTE:** Only Internet Explorer 11 on Windows will work for installation of the legacy Amplifire *Authoring tool* as no other browser will run the required Silverlight plugin. Safari on the Mac platform still works, although various complicated security exceptions must be configured during the install. The web version of Amplifire is tested and supported only on desktops, laptops and tablet devices, not on mobile phones, although it may function adequately on phone browsers.
