Obstetrics & Gynecology	A fellowship affidavit form will automatically print during the examination process. The form must be signed by the current program director, and faxed to the ABOG office. This form serves to document satisfactory completion or near completion of the fellowship training. Pediatrics	An applicant will be asked to list the program(s) where fellowship training occurred as well as the name(s) of the program directors. The ABP will send Verification of Competence Form to the program director(s) for completion.
