

Browser & OS Support

We focus our support for *any* browser on *any* platform to those that have a significant market share, as determined by the number of active learners we see using them in our regular traffic analysis. Current support is for Firefox 60 & 61, and Chrome 67 & 68. On Windows 10, support is for Edge 16 & 17, plus Internet Explorer 11, which is the only remaining Microsoft legacy browser in significant use. On the Mac platform for OSX, Safari 11.1 is tested.

NOTE: On Windows, only Internet Explorer 11 will allow installation of the legacy Amplifire *Authoring tool* as no other browser will run the required Silverlight plugin. Safari on the Mac platform still works, although various complicated security exceptions must be configured during the install. The regular web version of Amplifire is tested and supported only on desktops, laptops and tablets, not on mobile phones, although it may function quite adequately on phone browsers.
