Note: Reporting, Admin and Authoring are not supported on mobile platforms, Android or iPad.

NOTE: Our support is based on standard browser packages downloaded directly from the manufacturer, with *no* enterprise or individual modifications, <u>especially extensions</u>.

Amplifire is tested and supported only on desktops, laptops and tablets, not on mobile phones, although it may function effectively on phone browsers.
