

Release Notes for *amplifire*[™] version 7.25

New or Updated Functionality

Learning:

The Review experience has been updated to allow for improved consistency and usability. In addition to its primary function as a valuable practice tool, these changes position Review as a report. Now a student will see right and wrong answer 'attempt icons' by all questions that will indicate which ones they had the most difficulty with.

Also, individual questions can now be fully expanded to display all answer choices along with the corresponding "What You Need to Know" explanation.

New Instructor Review:

Instructors are provided with a new "Review" button in reporting enabling them to view not only the list of modules in a Course, but also individual questions. This is a significant workflow improvement for instructors, who previously had to work through a module as a learner just to see the questions that were included. Reporting:

In some situations when a user tried to change courses in the reporting dashboard, an application error was triggered which forced them to sign out and back in. This is now fixed.

System:

- Account administrators will now be able to remove learners from an existing course. This was not previously possible.
- Several display issues with the software audio controls for the iPad have been fixed.

Accessibility:

Our *amplifire* platform has obtained Accessibility Certification through a third party review, affirming that it fulfills requirements for the U.S. Government's Voluntary Product Accessibility Template (VPAT), Section 508, and WCAG 2.0. Browser & OS Support

Browser support details and changes

We are beginning to transition our support focus – for *any* browser on *any* platform – to those that have a significant market share, as determined by the number of active learners using them as seen in our daily traffic analysis.

- Due to rapidly declining use since the previous release, support for Firefox 40 and Chrome 43, 44, and 45 has been deprecated. Currently supported versions are Firefox 41 and 42, and Chrome 46, as indicated in the charts below.
- Google Chrome is not supported for installation of the Authoring tool on any platform due to its incompatibility with the Silverlight plugin.
- The web version of **amplifire** is supported only on desktops, laptops and tablet type devices, not on mobile phones.
