Composing an Abstract for Principal Call for Abstracts for Podium (Oral) Submissions

Choose the Right Track

- **Align your abstract** with the track that best matches your content **focus and intent**.
- Review the “**Content Focus**,” “**Who Should Submit**,” and “**Target Audience**” in each track description located in the Principal Call Resource Library to ensure a strong fit
- If your work bridges tracks, choose the **primary** area your content most directly addresses.

Highlight What’s Innovative, Evidence-Informed, and Impactful

- Submissions should:
 - Address **practice gaps** in hospice and palliative care.
 - Support **interdisciplinary and inclusive approaches**.
 - Demonstrate **evidence-informed strategies** that enhance the competence, skills and performance of hospice and palliative care providers.

Tailor Your Abstract for the Review Criteria

- Respond to required elements: Review the Principal Call Reviewer Guidelines and Rubric located in the Principal Call Resource Library
- Use **clear, jargon-free language**.
- Ensure your abstract demonstrates **relevance, rigor, originality, and applicability**.

Amplify Interdisciplinary Voices

- Submissions from **all disciplines and career stages** are encouraged.
- Co-presenters from **different roles or professions** can strengthen the interdisciplinary value.

Know Your Audience

- Think about who will attend your session and how your content will help them.
- Aim to provide practical takeaways and insights for learners at all career stages.
